

## Coordinates In Status Bar

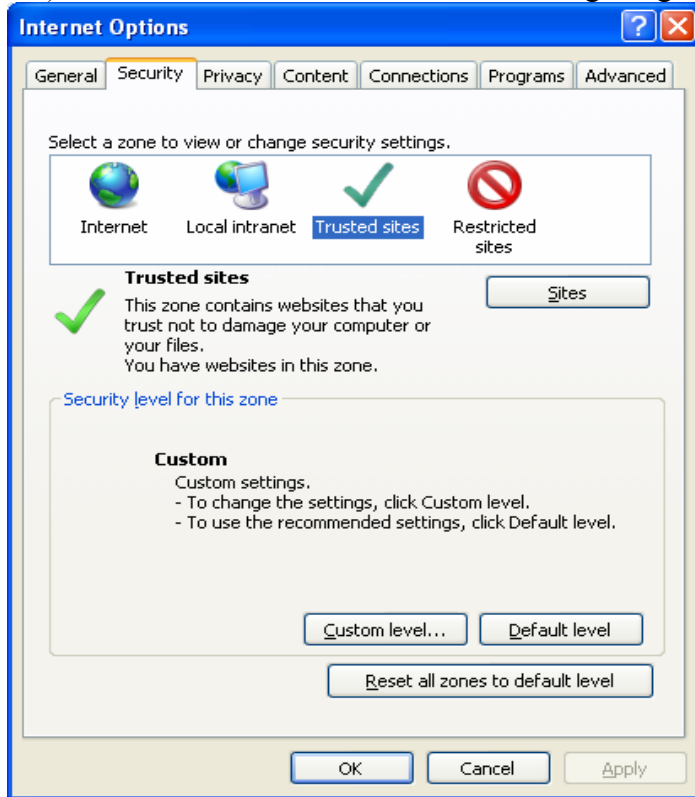
There are two ways to get coordinates to show up in the bottom status bar: 1) add [www.kgis.org](http://www.kgis.org) as a trusted site. 2) allow status bar updates via script must be enabled.

1) Click on the Tools menu on the Internet Explorer window.

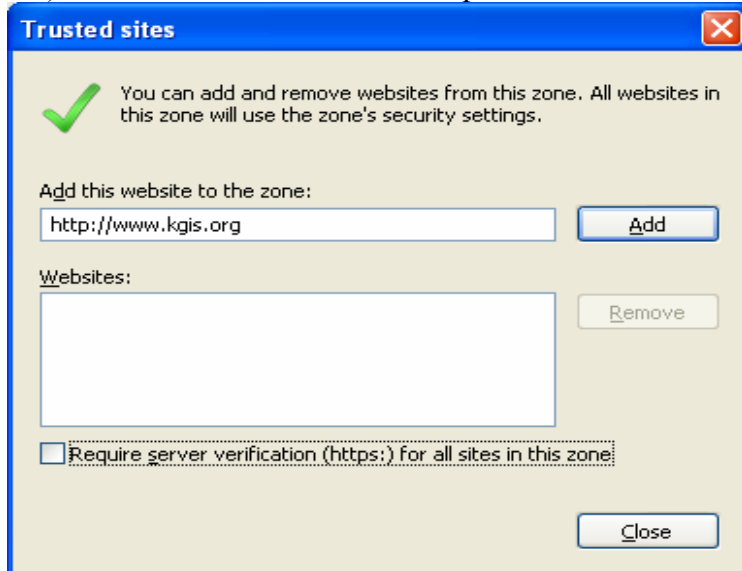

- 1.b) Next, click on the **Security Tab**
- 1.c) Click on the **Trusted Sites** icon.
- 1.d) Check on the **Sites** button to add [www.kgis.org](http://www.kgis.org)



- 1.e) Unmark the check box for Require server verification at the bottom.
- 1.f) Type in <http://www.kgis.org> and click the Add button.
- 1.g) Click close on this menu and OK on the menu above.
- 1.h) Close the IE window out and open a new one.



- 2) IE window click **Tools – Options – Advanced** tab
- 2.a) Scroll down the list till you get to Allow Status bar updates via script
- 2.b) Check the radio button beside Enable.
- 2.c) Click OK on this menu and OK on the options menu.
- 2.d) Close the IE window and open a new one.
- 2.e) Type in the KGIS mapping site- <http://www.kgis.org/KnoxNetWhere/viewer.asp>
