Comments:	This is a request for a new, 250 foot lattice type telecommunications tower that will support up to five telecommunications carrier antenna arrays. The tower will be located on a 34 acre tract that has access to Wise Springs Rd SprintCom. Inc. will be leasing a 10,000 square foot area for the tower and support facility. Sprint PCS will locate on the tower. The lease area is approximately 500' east of the nearest dwelling which is located on the owner's property. The required setback within the A (Agricultural) District is 35'. The tower will be located approximately 103' from the nearest property line. The nearest off site dwelling is over 800' from the tower site.
	 security fence. The perimeter of the fenced area will be landscaped as identified on the attached landscape plan. The site is located in a wooded area that will buffer the visual impact of the tower. Dual strobe lights will be required at this location due to the proposed height of the tower. Attached to the staff report are several support documents, including a report from MPC's tower consultant, Mr. Larry E. Perry. Mr. Perry's report describes SprintCom's tower proposal and highlights his findings. Mr. Perry finds that the 250' tower has been technically justified by both his direct measurements and by the application materials submitted to the Planning Commission.
