Comments: In a memo dated October 6, 2009, the City of Knoxville Law Department requested MPC to consider an

amendment of the City of Knoxville Zoning Ordinance at Article V, Section 6(D)(5) "Division of a lot". The proposed amendment would return the language of this section to its status prior to an amendment

approved by City Council on March 25, 2008.

Article V, Section 6(D)(5) was changed in its entirety in 2008 as part of a "housekeeping" effort that rearranged wording in the ordinance without meaning to add any new content. It is now apparent that the rearrangement, for the sake of simplification, has unintentionally changed the meaning of the ordinance. Under the 2008 revisions, a significant number of small lots "created by deed" prior to

annexation into the City can no longer be recorded and developed.
