Comments: The proposed ordinance revision defining craft industries and identifying those districts in which this

use will be permitted is a reflection of the changing nature of businesses and the trend toward smaller businesses making/creating products locally. The impetus for the ordinance change comes from a local restaurant business wishing to expand by starting a bakery at a new location to make bread for the restaurant, and possibly for other restaurants, and include a retail component at the place of business. The City of Knoxville Zoning Ordinance currently does not address this type of small craft industry, other than craft breweries, wineries, and distilleries, and thus uses of this type other than breweries, wineries, and distilleries are not permitted. The proposed amendment defines craft industries and includes craft breweries in the definition. It establishes maximum size limits for the use and allows a office, retail, eating/drinking, and/or event facility component with the use. Craft

industries are identified in the proposed amendment as a use on review in the C-3, C-4, C-5, C-6, and

C-7 commercial districts and as a permitted use in the I-2 industrial district.
