The proposed RAE zoning is consistent with the Northwest County Sector Plan proposal for the site.</li> <li>2. The site is located within the Planned Growth Area on the Knoxville-Knox County-Farragut Growth Policy Plan.</li> <li>3. There is a low density residential subdivision developed to the west, zoned PR (Planned Residential) at a density of up to 5 du/ac.</li> </ul>

RAE zoning provides for residential areas with low population densities. These areas are intended to be defined and protected from encroachment of uses not performing a function necessary to the residential environment.</li> <li>2. Based on the above description, this site is appropriate for RAE zoning.</li> <li>3. If connected to sewer, the RAE zone allows detached residential development with a minimum lot size of 10,000 sq. ft. Without sewer, the minimum lot size is 20,000 sq. ft., subject to approval by Knox County Health Department.</li> </ul>

If a plat is submitted to subdivide or record the property, a right-of-way dedication may be required.
