Comments: 1. A portion of S. Bell Street was previously closed as a result of the new KCDC/Austin Homes

Redevelopment. A short section of S. Bell Street remains between E. Summit Hill and Fort Summit Way (private). As a result, S. Bell Street is now disconnected between Fort Summit Way (private) and the remaining right-of-way north of parcel 095AH02501. This disconnect is a safety concern for emergency responders. Renaming this section of S Bell Street to Fort Summit Way (public) will

eliminate possible confusion.

2. Addressing staff requested this name change to provide clarity as stated above. Staff has approved

the proposed street name and all owners have signed the petition in favor of the change.

3. If the street name change is approved, no addresses will be changed.

4. If approved, the new street name must be identified on the final subdivision plat for Austin Homes

Redevelopment and recorded with the Register of Deeds.

5. Staff has received no objections to the renaming of this right-of-way.

6. It meets all requirements of the "Addressing Guidelines and Procedures" section of Knoxville-Knox

County's Administrative Rules and Procedures as well as those in the City of Knoxville's Code of

Ordinances, Chapter 23, Article IV, Section 23-108.
