Comments: The MPC staff will be conducting a consultant selection process to award federal Surface

Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds for consulting services to perform a transportation corridor study for the portion of Chapman Highway within the Knoxville City Limits. TDOT has oversight of the federal STBG funds that will be used for this project and therefore the MPC must adhere to its procedures to ensure that federal regulations, rules, policies and standards are met. This includes having the Planning Commission formally adopt the policies set forth to ensure an appropriate and fair process is conducted to select a qualified consultant for services that are desired to be contracted for. Attached is the local version of the TDOT consultant selection policy that designates the parameters that the MPC will follow in conducting consultant selection based on Planning Commission approval. The policy specifies the procurement methods, types of contracts, the use of a consultant evaluation committee, the requirement that a consultant be on TDOT's prequalified list for the type of service to be performed and other requirements. One feature of the policy to highlight is the two-phase

evaluation process that begins with a request for qualifications (RFQ) and letters of interest (LOI) that are first evaluated in order to determine a shortlist (usually 3 firms) that are then requested to provide a full proposal for the second phase of evaluation. This process should save time and effort for both the

responding consultants as well as the reviewing agencies involved in the evaluation process.
