1.07 AMENDMENTS

The Planning Commission may from time to time revise or modify or amend these regulations by appropriate action taken at a regularly scheduled meeting after the required notice and holding of a public hearing. A thirty (30) day public notice of the date, time and location of the public hearing shall

be published in a daily newspaper of general circulation in Knox County, Tennessee.

An amendment becomes effective when the Metropolitan Planning Commission approves it. The

amendment is forwarded to the City of Knoxville and Knox County as a matter of practice. The Executive Director of the Planning Commission is empowered and authorized by the Planning Commission to correct and amend these regulations as to the following non-substantive matters, without public notice or public hearing: spelling; change in case and punctuation; references to sections of the Tennessee Code Annotated to conform with amendments thereto; the enumeration of
