Comments: REQUEST

City Council recently amended the City of Knoxville Zoning Ordinance to require the notification of all property owners of a proposed general amendment to its zoning map. Previously, general amendments to the zoning map were exempt from individual notice of proposed changes. To accommodate this change in the zoning ordinance, MPC administrative rules must be amended as

well.

BACKGROUND

City council originally proposed written notice by first class mail to all property owners and the posting of signs on all property within an area proposed for a general amendment of the zoning map. After receiving a recommendation from the planning commission, the amendment to the ordinance was changed to require only a notice to all property owners within the proposed area of map amendment.

The proposed amendments to the MPC administrative rules reflect the zoning ordinance amendments and allow the MPC to recover the costs of mailing from the initiator of the proposal in the event of a

significantly large general map amendment.
