Projects are selected from a prioritized list that is generated by the Knoxville Engineering Department. State Street Garage Addition This project calls for the addition of two additional levels of parking to be added to the existing garage. Urban Wilderness Development Program This programs the ongoing improvements to the Urban Wilderness Corridor Complete descriptions and funding totals for all projects are included in the CIP document.
