Merchant Drive at Clinton Highway Intersection Improvements

This program item will include improvements (signals and refuge islands) to this intersection to allow

for more efficient turning movements for vehicles and safer pedestrian crossings.

Magnolia Avenue Streetscapes

Streetscape improvements will be made to four blocks of Magnolia Avenue from Jessamine Street to

North Bertrand Street.

Bicycle Infrastructure Improvements

Network deficiencies on the designated bicycle routes within the City will be addressed. These routes

connect four major residential areas: North, South, East, and West to Downtown Knoxville.

Blighted Property Acquisition/Chronic Problem Properties

A two prong approach to improve neighborhoods the City will continue the acquisition of blighted property and the assembly of property for redevelopment. The City will also address chronic problem

properties through acquisition and lower cost stabilizations.
