RA zoning is compatible with the scale and intensity of the surrounding development and zoning pattern in the area.</li> <li>2. The proposed RA zoning is consistent with the Northwest City Sector Plan proposal for the site.</li> <li>3. If approved, the applicant would have the potential to subdivide the property into lots of less than 1 acre. The minimum lot size under the current A zoning would be 1 acre. If connected to sewer, the RA zone allows detached residential development with a minimum lot size of 10,000 sq. ft. Without sewer, the minimum lot size is 20,000 sq. ft., subject to approval by Knox County Health Department.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT SHALL NOT ADVERSELY AFFECT ANY OTHER PART OF THE COUNTY, NOR SHALL ANY DIRECT OR INDIRECT ADVERSE EFFECTS RESULT FROM SUCH AMENDMENT:</li> <li>1. The applicant intends to subdivide the subject property into two or more residential lots. The current A zoning requires a minimum lot size of one acre. RA zoning will allow this 1.8 acre site to be subdivided into lots smaller than one acre in size.</li> <li>2. The impact to the street system will be minimal. With the plat submitted to subdivide the property, a right-of-way dedication of 30 feet from the centerline of Murray Dr. will be required.</li> <li>3. The proposed zoning is compatible with surrounding development, and there should be minimal impact to the surrounding area and no adverse affect to any other part of the County.</li> <li>4. Public water and sewer utilities are available in the area, but may need to be extended to serve the site.</li> <li>5.
