Comments: Request:

Knox County Commission at its June 28, 2010 meeting requested that MPC study the issue of flea

markets in the Knox County Zoning Ordinance and recommend appropriate amendments.

Background:

The Knox County Zoning Ordinance currently defines flea markets as follows:

FLEA MARKET - The occasional or periodic sale held in an open area where groups of individual sellers offer goods for sale to the public and the sale goods are moved off the premise between sale

dates.

Flea markets are listed as permitted uses in the CA (General Business), CB (Business and

Manufacturing) and CH (Highway Commercial) zone districts.

There are currently no standards specific to flea markets in the Zoning Ordinance.

Analysis:

A review of zoning regulations of other jurisdictions was completed. The Knox County definition and

zones where permitted are comparable to those ordinances observed.

Many cities and counties allow flea markets as conditional or specific uses. Most require special permits and many established minimum standards of operation for such items as minimum size of

parcel, access, days of operation, parking, lighting, screening, vendors licensing and site plan approval.
